SCHOOL STARTS NEXT MONTH!

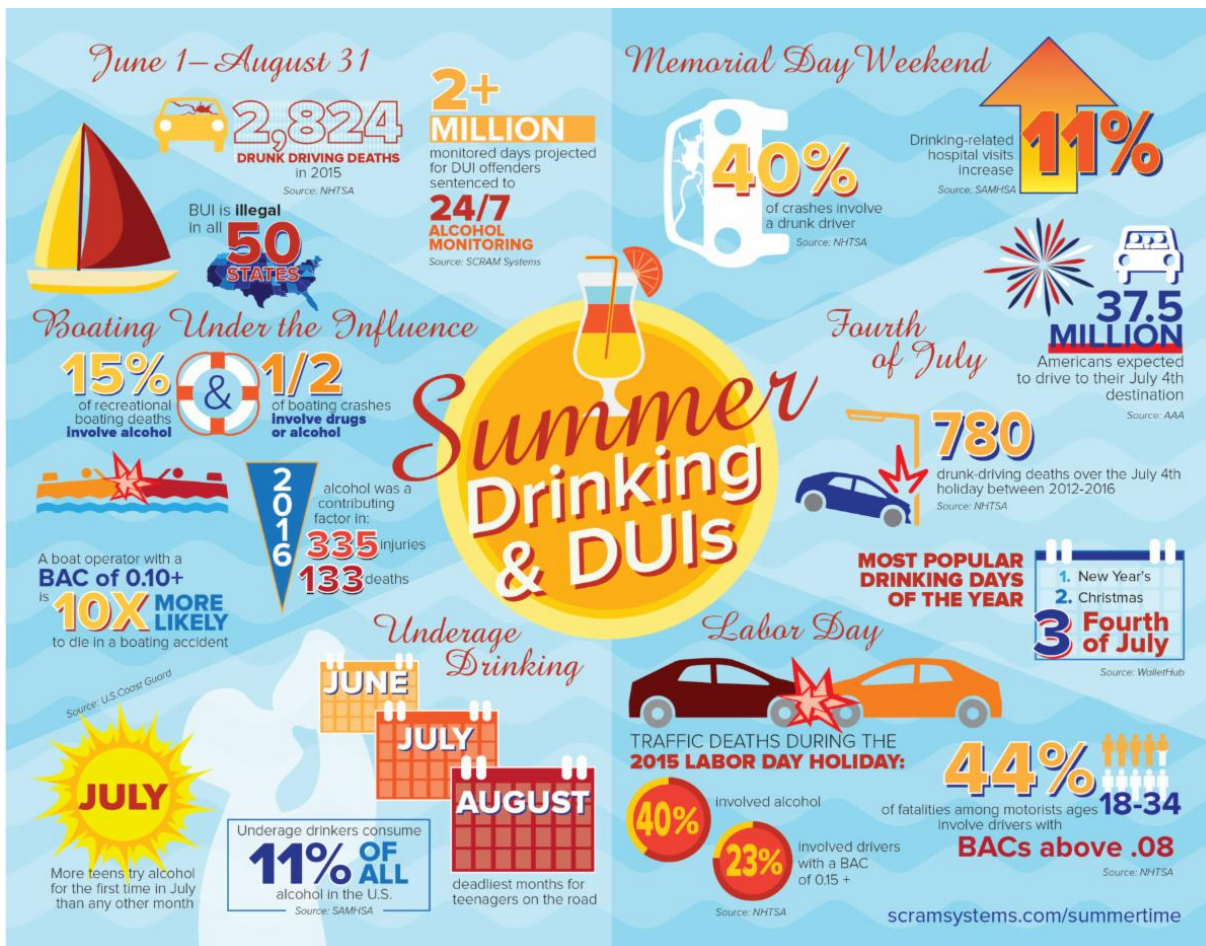

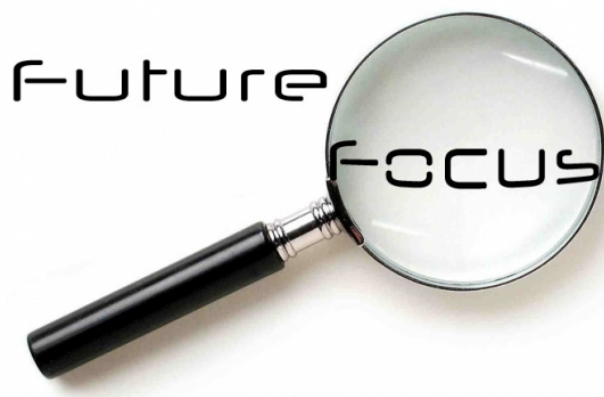

Did you know?

- During this year's Independence Day holiday weekend (6:01 pm Friday, July 2 to 11:59 pm Monday, July 5), the CHP conducted a **statewide Maximum Enforcement Period (MEP)**, with the goal of keeping California's roadways safe for everyone.
- Throughout the MEP, CHP officers made **997 DUI arrests**, which translates to approximately **one arrest every 5 minutes**.
- Sadly, at least **43 people were killed** in crashes during this period.

A Message From Our CEO

DATA FROM AAC'S END OF THE YEAR SURVEYS ARE ROLLING IN! We sent a survey to teachers and students who participated in the Virtual Real DUI Court in Schools Program during the 2020-2021 school year. We do this to measure the impact and effectiveness of our programming long after the emotional response is gone. Here are a few results:

- 96% remained mindful of the dangers and consequences of drinking and driving months after viewing our presentation.
- 78% shared the information they learned during our presentation with their friends and family.
- 46% of the participants who admitted to consuming and/or drinking and driving indicated they changed their behavior because they were impacted by the presentation.
